TotalEnergies Ep Uganda (Company) in its capacity as Operator of Contract Area 1 (CA - 1) and License Area 2 North (LA - N), in conjunction with its Joint Venture partner(s), invites experienced and reputable companies to express interest in the provision of consultancy services to conduct Environment Studies, Environment and Social Management Plans and Permitting Requirements in respect of the development of the TILENGA project, TILENGA Feeder Pipeline project and any other site as and when stipulated by the Company, for the period of 2024 – 2027.

The Tilenga project is located in the North-East area of Lake Albert in Uganda and covers the fields in CA-1 block and the Northern part of LA-2 block.

Scope of services:

The Scope of services will include provision of personnel, materials, equipment, and logistics necessary to carry out studies in accordance with the National Environment (Environment and Social Impact Assessment) Regulations, 2020, National Environment Management Act, 2019, and other applicable national laws, International standards and Company specifications. Services will include, but not be limited to, the following:

- Undertake stand-alone studies including specialist studies/ assessments, risk assessments, trainings, supplementary environment and social impact assessments and/or project briefs as instructed by Company.
- Provide support to Company for development and implementation of management plans as identified in the respective environment and social Impact assessments and/or project briefs.
- Provide support in the preparation of permit applications required for the Tilenga project and Tilenga Feeder Pipeline project in line with applicable regulatory requirements.

Minimum requirements for interested companies

- Current registration in Uganda; or application to be registered to; the Petroleum Authority of Uganda National

Supplier Database (NSD).

- Experience (not less than 5 years) in providing similar assignments i.e. environment studies, risk assessments, environment and social management plans and permitting requirements services.
- An environmental assessment team of persons duly certified and registered in accordance with the National Environment (Conduct and Certification of Environmental Practitioners) Regulations, 2003.
- Adequate financial capability to perform the services.
- Possess appropriate licensing from relevant in-country authorities for the provision of the services.
- Registered partnership / firm with the National Environment Management Authority (NEMA).

Statements of EOI should be no more than ten (10) pages long and should include the following:

- Description of deliverables
- Proposed scope, level of effort and duration
- Qualification of team leader(s) and key personnel who would be providing the service
- Summary of related experience and expertise with similar work and selected references.
- Proposed partnerships if relevant
- Cost estimates are not to be included in the EOI.
- Contractors must be qualified to conduct the work as outlined above and should demonstrate previous experience in the effective delivery of similar services.
