

REQUEST FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR MAINTENANCE SERVICES FOR RECIPROCATING COMPRESSORS REFERENCE: 10177858

TotalEnergies EP Uganda (COMPANY) in its capacity as Operator of Contract Area (CA) 1 and License Area (LA) 2, in conjunction with its Joint Venture partner(s), invite experienced and reputable contractors to express their interest in providing maintenance services for the operation of the future facilities in respect of the Tilenga Project, Lake Albert Basin, Republic of Uganda as further described below.

General Field Development Description:

The Tilenga oil and associated gas development is located in the Northern area of Lake Albert in Uganda and covers the fields in CA-1 block and the Northern part of LA-2 block (Tilenga Project).

The major development surface facilities include the following:

- · Well pads (31) and the upstream gathering network
- The Industrial Area containing temporary facilities and the Central Processing Facility (CPF)
- The associated supporting infrastructure (camps, roads, aerodromes etc.)

Maintenance Services for the Reciprocating Compressors for the Operational Phase

The scope of work covers the provision of maintenance services in support of COMPANY operations, which activities will include but not limited to the provision of following:

- Trained and competent technical field engineers to support planned and corrective maintenance activities for reciprocating compressors.
- Remote technical support and diagnostic services to maintain system availability
- · Training and development of site staff
- · Contract management and reporting

Interested parties may participate in this EOI as a single entity or as an association of companies, where they shall (individually or collectively) demonstrate the following minimum requirements.

Minimum Technical Requirements

- Experience in maintenance and overhaul of API Reciprocating Compressors
- Capacity to provide experienced field service engineers for the energy or other major sectors of the industry
- Expertise in the operation and troubleshooting of Reciprocating Compressors
- · Execution of technical training related to the services
- · Provision of remote technical support services
- · Contract management

In addition to the above-mentioned technical capacity, the minimum requirements to participate in the Prequalification Process are:

- Health Safety and Environment (HSE) Management system, Quality Policy and related procedures in compliance with local and international standards
- The required insurances for the services including contractor employees
- · Adequate financial capacity to undertake the eventual contract
- Demonstrate commitment to the statutory National Content requirements for oil and gas operations as detailed in the 2016 Upstream Petroleum Regulations.
- Current registration to or application to be registered to; the National Supplier Database.

EOI participation

Following receipt of the EOI email request, COMPANY shall register the interested parties in its e-sourcing platform ARIBA[™], to enable the interested parties to submit their completed prequalification questionnaires.
