

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST (EOI) FOR THE PROVISION OF BUSES FOR THE TILENGA PROJECT CREW CHANGE REFERENCE: 10295478

TotalEnergies EP UGANDA (COMPANY) as Operator of Contract Area (CA) 1 and License Area (LA) 2 North, in conjunction with its Joint Venture partner(s), invites experienced and reputable companies to express interest to provide buses with 30 to 40 seats for the provision of transport services during the crew change of the Tilenga Project.

General Field Development Description:

The Tilenga project is located in the North-East area of Lake Albert in Uganda and covers the fields in CA-1 block and the Northern part of LA-2 block. There are four vertically stacked reservoirs that are developed in the project. The reservoirs are presumed to be disconnected and will be developed individually. Laterally, the reservoirs are compartmentalized through a series of faults. The surface facilities include wellpads (30+) and an industrial area containing a Central Processing Facility (CPF) and facilities. There is re-injection of produced water into the reservoirs.

Scope of Work broadly includes:

To provide brand-new executive buses with 30 -40 seats on an operating lease. The executive buses should have ABS, Airbags, 3 points seat belts, reclining seats, USB charging ports on every seat, headrest on all seats, diesel engine, lane departure warning, and forward crash warning.

The Minimum Requirements to Participate in the Pregualification Process are:

- The vendor MUST be registered on the Oil and Gas National Supplier Database.
- Financial Capacity to supply the required brand-new buses.
- Meet the minimum bus specifications as described in the Scope of Work, where high safety standards and comfort are a key consideration
- Must be authorized or in partnership with the original bus manufacturer/ brand being proposed
- Must have an established maintenance workshop in Uganda with adequate parts stock levels
- · Performance of similar services in Uganda
- Demonstrated commitment to statutory National Content requirements for oil and gas operations as detailed in 2016 Upstream Petroleum Regulations.
- · Must have suitably qualified and experienced personnel
- Compliance to National and International laws and regulations.
- Must have a Health, Safety and Environment (HSE)
 Management system, Quality Policy and related procedures in compliance with local and international standards.
